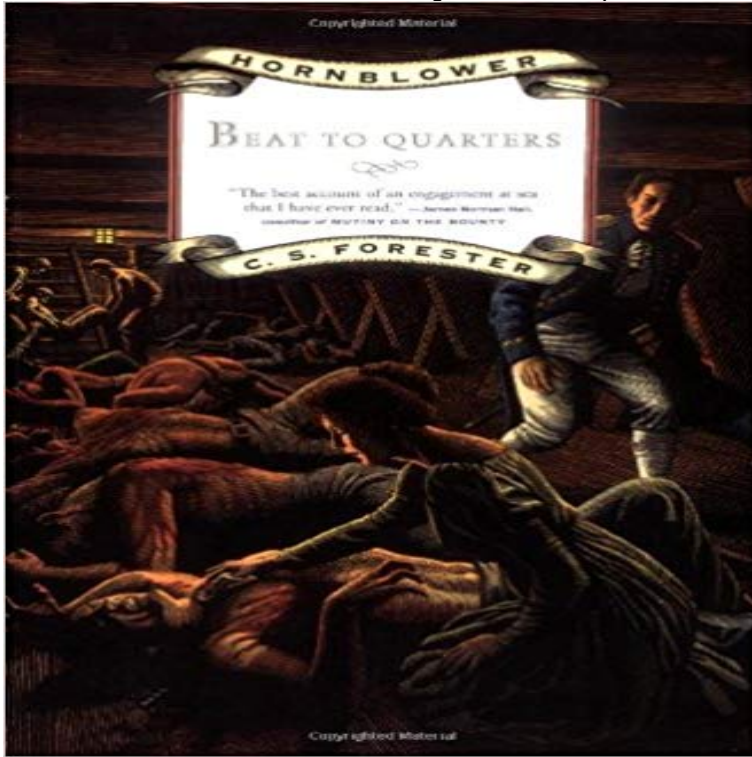


Hornblower: Beat to Quarters (Hornblower Saga)
