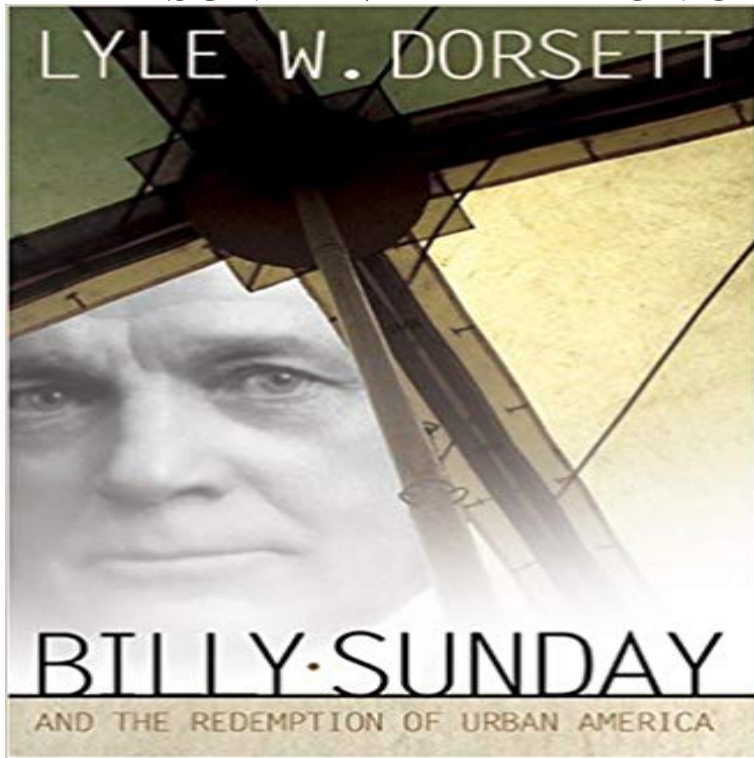


BILLY SUNDAY/REDEMPTION OF AMERICA
