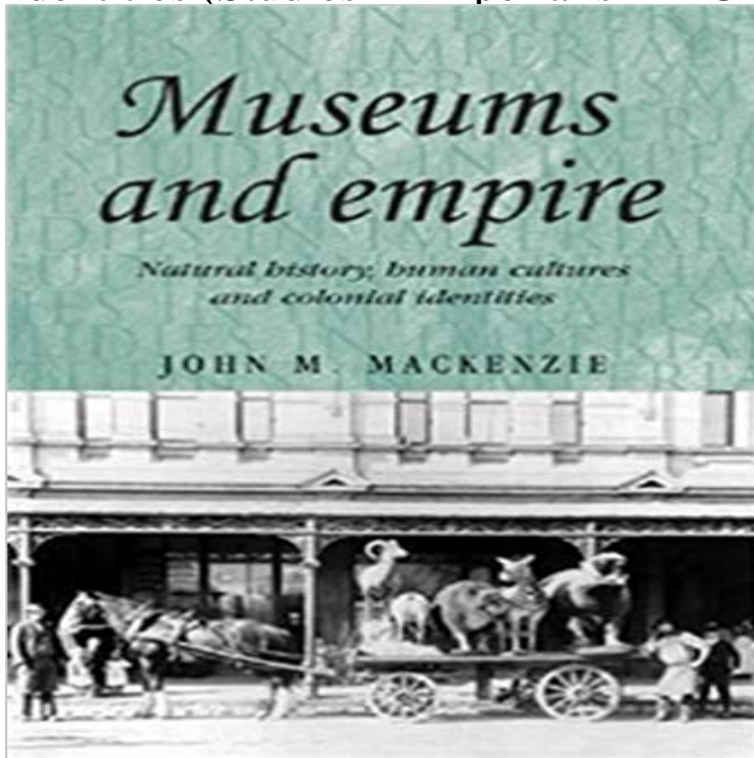


# Museums and empire: Natural history, human cultures and colonial identities (Studies in Imperialism MUP)
